Internship Program

HATponics' Responsibilities

- All interns will be assigned to a HATponics staff member for training and supervision.
- HATponics supervisors will be responsible for scheduling workdays and hours according to the school's internship requirements.
- HATponics supervisors will be responsible for completing school reports / evaluations from the college.
- Supervisors will be available to discuss the intern's progress and address questions and concerns.
- HATponics will make information regarding policies, procedures, rules and regulations available to the intern prior to the beginning of the internship.
- HATponics does not provide stipends or any other benefits during the course of the internship.

Intern's Responsibilities

- Interns are required to complete all work hours agreed upon in the initial contract.
- Interns must contact their supervisor within 30 minutes of a scheduled start time if they must be absent or late. Repeated absenteeism or tardiness may lead to termination from the program.
- All interns are expected to conduct themselves in a safe and responsible manner.
- Please use good judgment and common sense in matters of safety, and observe all safety rules and policies.
- Personal use of telephones should be limited to emergencies and extenuating circumstances. All personal calls should be brief. Cell phones must be kept on vibrate or off during work hours.
- Interns are subject to ALL HATponics employee rules and guidelines, including the dress code.
- Interns, in accordance with our employee drug policy, may be subject to random drug testing.
